THE T. RICHARDSON MINER, JR. SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

NEAHP established The T. Richardson Miner, Jr. Scholarship Fund in April 1996 honoring our colleague, Rich Miner, for his long-standing and devoted service to NEAHP and his commitment to the pursuit of educational excellence for health care development professionals.

This annual scholarship award funds the full cost of tuition for the recipient's attendance at [The AHP Institute for Healthcare Philanthropy](#) held each year for one week in July at the University of Wisconsin, Madison, Wisconsin. In addition, NEAHP will reimburse the recipient up to \$1,000 in housing and transportation costs. *(Please keep in mind that NEAHP must use its limited resources judiciously and effectively. Every effort should be made by the recipient to use the lowest cost available housing and transportation. Reservations should be made early to take advantage of promotional rates and fares.)*

Scholarship applications must be submitted no later than **Friday, February 16, 2018**. The scholarship committee will review all applications and announce its selection of the recipient at the 2018 NEAHP Educational Conference in Woodstock, VT.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- 1) The applicant must have a current membership in the NEAHP at the time of application.
- 2) The applicant must submit the completed scholarship application form along with a written statement including a brief history of his/her fund raising experience; the reasons he/she wishes to attend the AHP Institute for Healthcare Philanthropy; and the reason he/she is deserving of the scholarship award.
- 3) The application and written statement must be emailed no later than February 16, 2018

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

- 1) The scholarship award must be used for attendance at The AHP Institute for Healthcare Philanthropy in the year it is awarded.
- 2) The funds will be applied toward registration, housing and transportation costs only. The recipient is responsible for paying all registration, housing, and transportation fees in advance. The scholarship award will be disbursed by NEAHP upon receipt of a written summary of the recipient's experience within 30 days following completion of the Institute and submission of conference registration, housing and travel receipts.
- 3) The recipient is responsible for per diem expenses during attendance at the Institute.
